



Spokane County Hospitality Relief Grant

Hospitality Helps

Access grant dollars to help your small business.

Spokane County has allocated CARES dollars to assist businesses in the hospitality industry that have experienced economic hardship due to the COVID-19 health emergency and related emergency shutdowns. Eligible applicants could receive up to \$20,000 toward working capital for payroll, rent, accounts payable, debt services and expenses related to shifts in operations in order to retain existing business, retain current employees or retain business viability for future re-employment.

Eligible applicants should apply between November 4-16, 2020. Check your eligibility and find the application online at Spokanehospitalitygrant.org.

The Spokane County Hospitality Relief Grant is a partnership of Visit Spokane, the Greater Spokane Valley Chamber of Commerce, Greater Spokane Incorporated and the Downtown Spokane Partnership, with assistance from the Washington Hospitality Association and AHANA. Grant applications will be processed by Innovia Foundation.

Apply between November 4 - 16, 2020



Eligibility:

Businesses must have primary operations in Spokane County with 249 or fewer employees as of March 1, 2020, been established and operating on or before March 1, 2020, have gross revenues greater than \$5,000 in either 2019 or 2020, have not permanently ceased operations, have an active business license with the Washington State Department of Revenue and are in good standing with the Washington State Department of Labor and Industries, and must demonstrate expenditures/losses due to the COVID-19 public health emergency. Gross revenues must not have been greater than \$10M in 2020.
